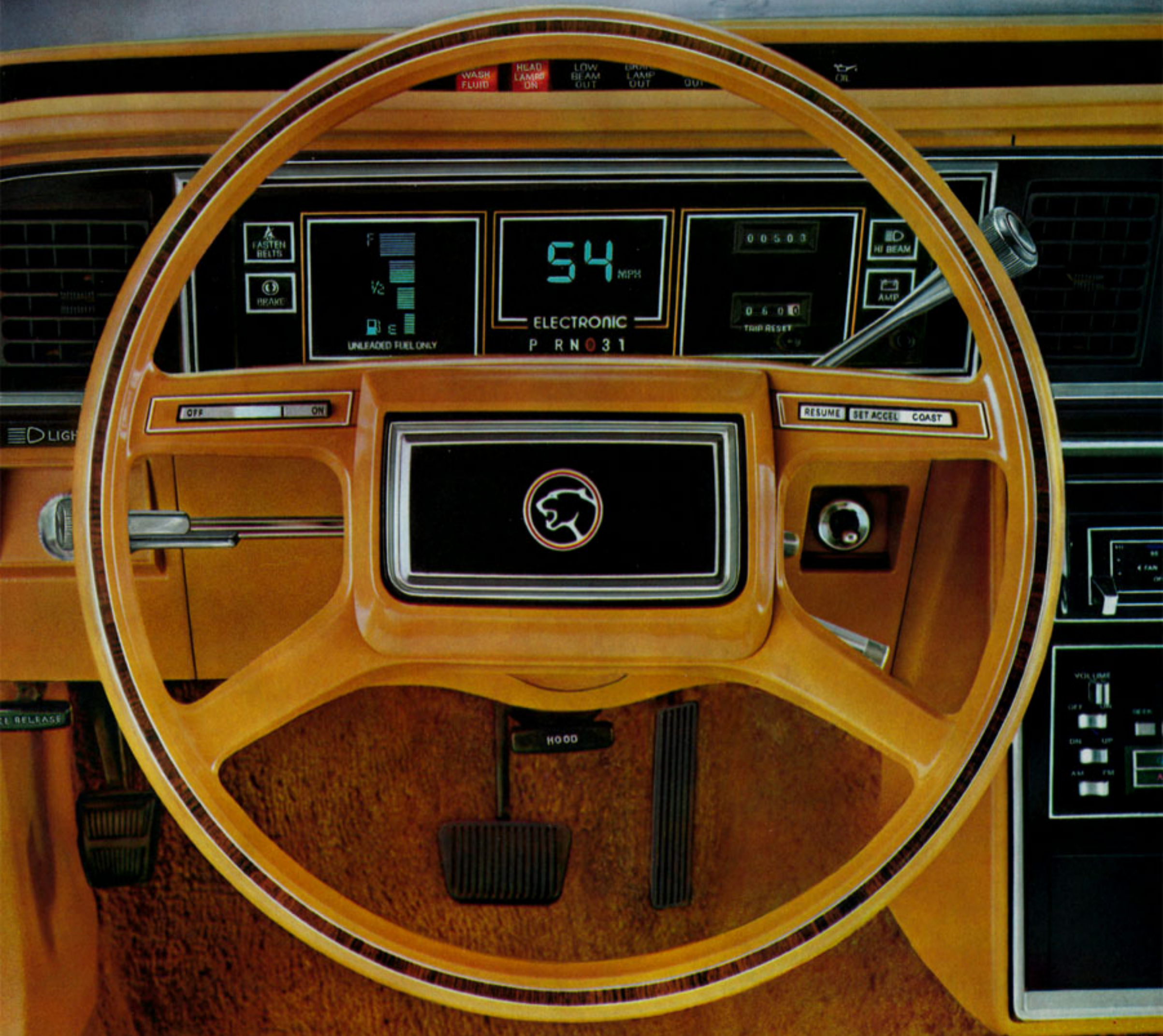

There is a definite flair to the Sports Group Cougar XR-7... a "look" heightened by special touches that include a Tu-tone paint treatment, dual bright remote control mirrors, hood and decklid accent stripes and color-keyed wide bodyside moldings. You can even add an available luxury half vinyl roof. Cornering lamps are also available. Functional standard features include TR Type radial white sidewall tires† and cast aluminum wheels.

Interior appointments of the Sports Group Cougar XR-7 are equally impressive. Some of the highlights include new Recaro bucket seats, luxury rear seat trim, luxury door and quarter trim appliques, power windows, and 18-ounce cut-pile carpeting.

- b. Code buttons on driver's door for optional Keyless Entry System. System consists of a minicomputer and group of relays to permit opening of doors and decklid through use of the code buttons. You merely touch buttons in a sequence code programmed into the minicomputer and the doors unlock. 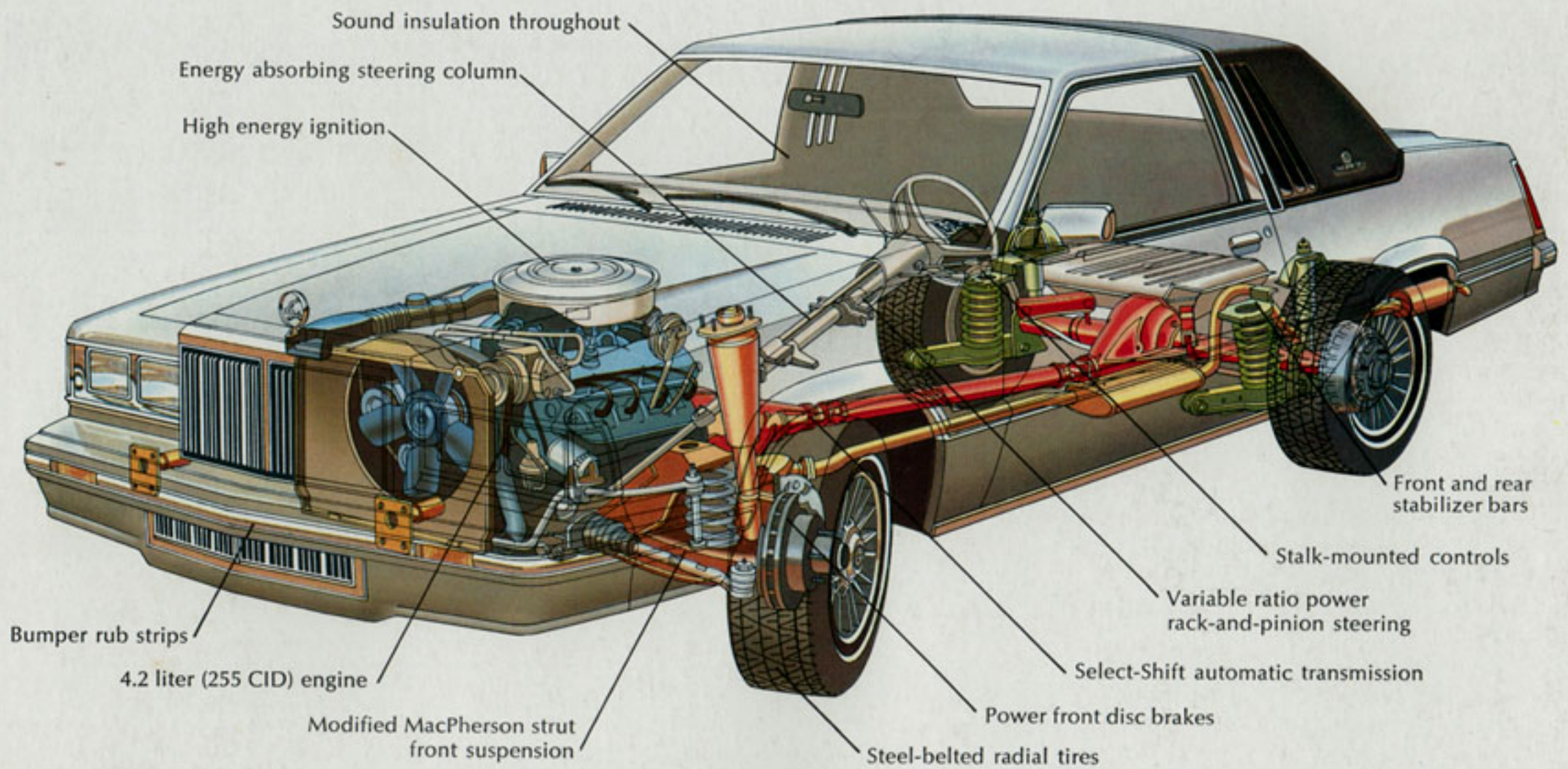

Cougar XR-7 Body. Constructed with a fully unitized body structure that replaces the previous separate body and frame design.

Cougar XR-7 Powertrain. Standard engine is the new 4.2 L (255 CID) V-8 designed to deliver V-8 performance while meeting new vehicle weight reduction requirements. (California engines include an Electronic Engine Control System.)

Cougar XR-7 Suspension. Utilizes a four-bar link rear suspension combined with a Modified MacPherson strut front suspension.

Corrosion Perforation Warranty. Ford Motor Company offers a three year, unlimited mileage corrosion perforation warranty on all new cars placed in service or delivered at retail on or after July 11, 1979. And it's free.

The warranty states that any part

which, in normal use, develops perforation from corrosion within three years of retail delivery or first use will be repaired or replaced free of charge by the selling dealer after inspection by a Ford representative.

Exhaust system components or parts which develop corrosion perforation caused by accidents or other damage are not covered.
