Outside, there's a distinctive Eddie Bauer two-tone paint treatment (shown on the cover and on page 2) which is available in five color combinations. Larger P205 RWL all-season radial tires are standard, and they're matched with handsomely styled cast aluminum wheels.

Extensively equipped

All the comfort that's built into the Bronco II XLT series is also in Eddie Bauer, along with some notable additions. Dual reclining front Captain's Chairs include a special cloth with vinyl fabric and feature power lumbar supports. Air conditioning, Privacy glass™ quarter windows, speed control and tilt steering wheel are all included. And unique Eddie Bauer garment and gear bags, trimmed in tan cloth and leather, are shipped directly to you from Eddie Bauer.

Bronco II XL, with its handsome list of standard features (page 13), is joined in 1988 by the XL Sport. Free-spirited Sport is easily identified by its distinctive outfitting, including a brush/grille guard, fog lamps, black tubular rear bumper, black front bumper (in place of the standard bumper), spats and front fascia. These items are optional with Bronco II XLT as well. They're called the Sport Appearance Package.

XLT additions

XLT is the comfort/convenience-oriented Bronco II. It includes cloth and vinyl upholstery, wrapover cloth door panels with map pockets and other trim extras. Also standard are the handy Light Group (detailed on page 13), an AM/FM stereo radio with digital clock, pivoting front vent windows and more.

Versatile Bronco II

Whichever Bronco II series you choose, you can be assured of a comfortable, well-equipped vehicle, V-6 powered and fitted with an electronically controlled anti-lock rear brake system (page 8).

ENGINEERING EXCELLENCE BRONCO II 2WD AND 4WD

Ford Bronco II employs today's technology to help its driver. The electronically controlled rear anti-lock brake system is designed to inhibit complete rear wheel lock-up under most operating conditions. Whenever rear wheel lock-up is detected, the computer processes signals and directs the pressure control valve to selectively modulate rear brake line hydraulic pressure. The result is enhanced driver ability to control braking performance (see illustration).

Spirited V-6 power

All Bronco IIs feature the 2.9 liter V-6 engine with its 140-horsepower output. It includes a multi-port fuel injection system (EFI) which is efficiently governed by the Ford-designed EEC-IV engine control computer. A sporty 5-speed manual overdrive transmission, standard, is synchronized in all gears — including reverse.

When it comes to towing, Bronco II allows for a gross combination weight rating (GCWR) of 8,500 pounds and a maximum trailer weight rating of 5,100 pounds in the 2WD model (5,000 pounds in the 4WD).^{*} A properly equipped Bronco II for this kind of towing includes the Automatic Overdrive transmission, 4.10 limited-slip rear axle, and the Super Engine Cooling Package.

The controls for the optional 4WD Touch-Drive are conveniently located in an overhead console.



Overdrive efficiency

The optional 4-speed automatic overdrive transmission (A4LD) provides a mechanical lock-up which eliminates power-wasting torque converter slippage, especially during highway travel. The electronically controlled converter clutch automatically engages during steady-speed operation in fourth gear and the upper range of third gear.

Special shocks for a smooth ride

All Bronco II models are equipped with gas-pressurized shock absorbers designed to help maintain proper hydraulic fluid pressure, even over a rapid succession of jarring bumps. The ride is smooth under normal circumstances, yet firm enough over rough road conditions.

Manual locking hubs

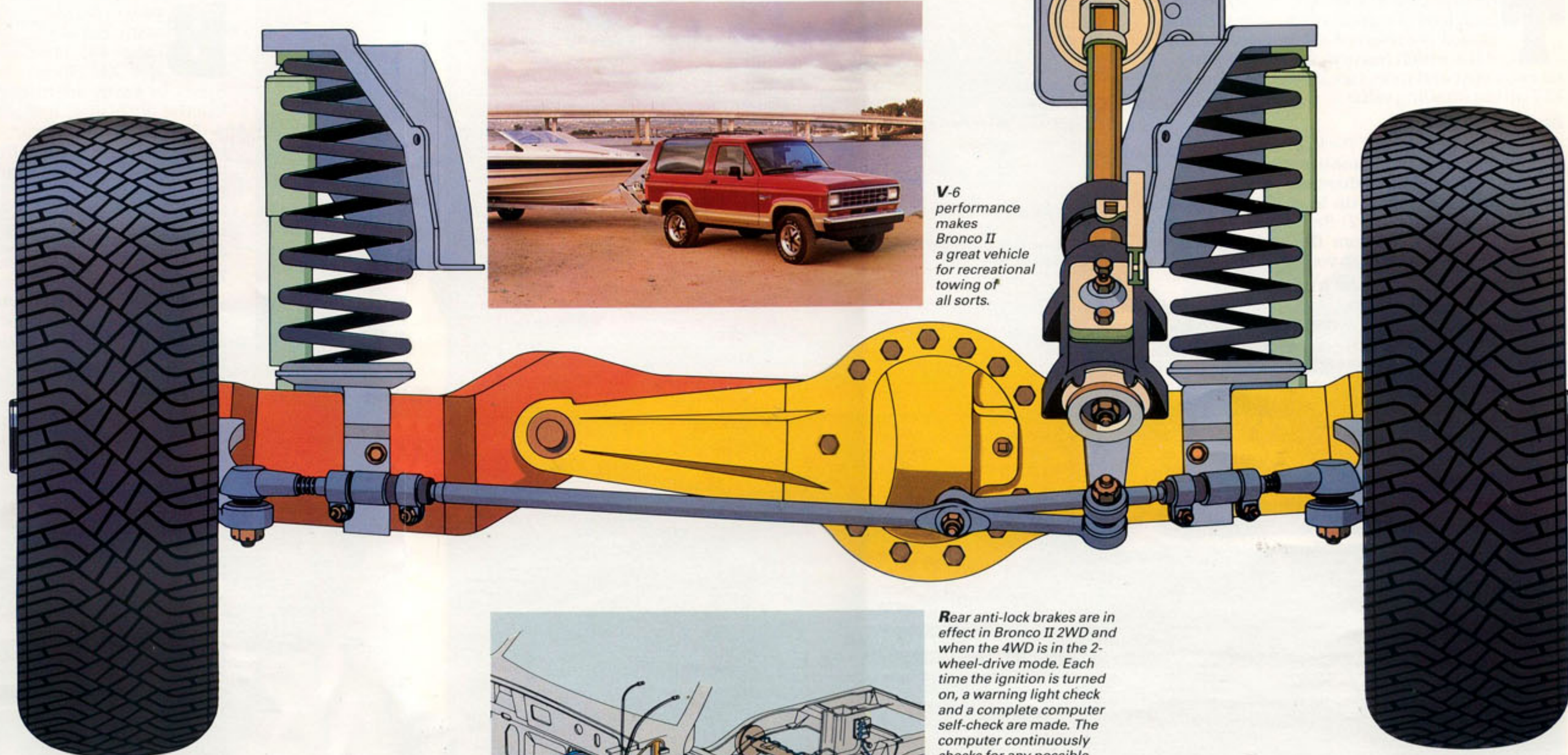
The 4WD standard free-running front hubs are the manual locking type. When the wheel hubs are locked, you can shift "on the fly" from 2-wheel high to 4-wheel high and back again to suit driving conditions.

The Touch-Drive option

Touch-Drive is the ultimate convenience for 4-wheel driving enjoyment. It allows shifting "on the fly" from 2-wheel high to 4-wheel high and back at any speed just by touching a button. The automatic locking hubs engage instantly because Touch-Drive employs an innovative magnetic clutch that spins up the front drive system from zero to driving speed in milliseconds.

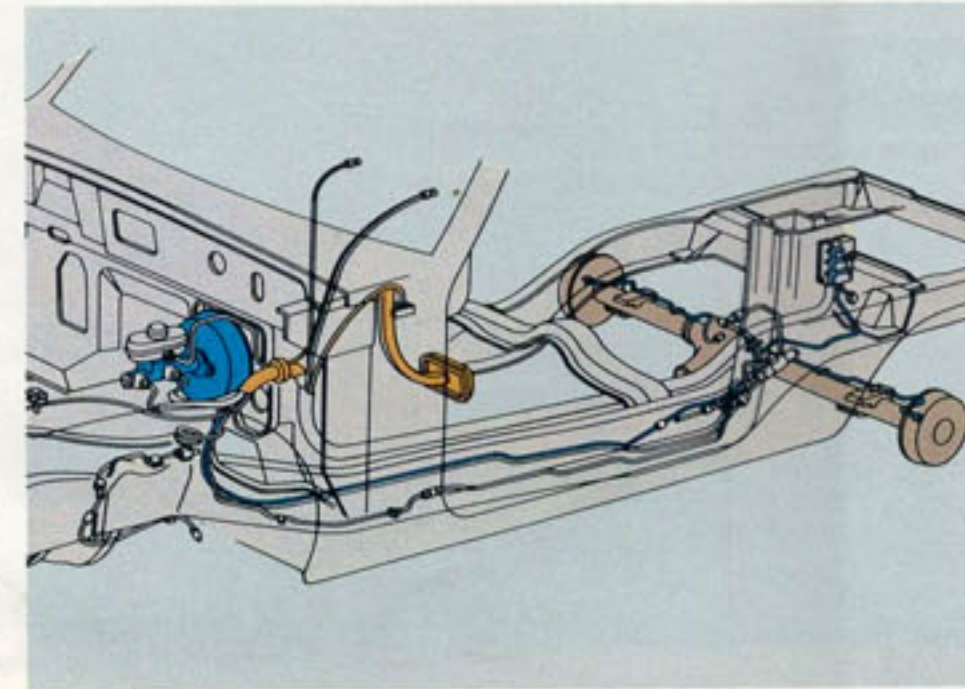
Two special electrical interlocks prevent possible powertrain damage that might otherwise be caused by a mis-shift between 4-high and 4-low. Shifting into or out of 4-low can only be done when the vehicle is either stopped or moving below 3 mph with the manual transmission clutch disengaged or the automatic transmission in neutral.

V-6 performance makes Bronco II a great vehicle for recreational towing of all sorts.

Ford-famous Twin-I-Beam independent front suspension is standard with the 2WD model and the Twin-Traction Beam system (shown above) with the 4WD. Each front wheel, with its own axle and hefty coil spring, steps over bumps independently to help cushion the ride and provide excellent handling.



Rear anti-lock brakes are in effect in Bronco II 2WD and when the 4WD is in the 2-wheel-drive mode. Each time the ignition is turned on, a warning light check and a complete computer self-check are made. The computer continuously checks for any possible electrical malfunction. In the unlikely event of a malfunction, the warning light on the instrument panel will alert the driver that the computer has automatically shut down the system and converted the rear brakes to conventional braking operation.

PREFERRED EQUIPMENT PACKAGES

The Bronco II XLT at right illustrates the high level of equipment in this series. Included is Preferred Equipment Package 931A which features air conditioning at no extra cost and more (see below), making this XLT an outstanding value.

An easy way to buy

Preferred Equipment Packages are groups of popular features. By combining them, we simplify the ordering procedure. All you have to do is: (1) Decide on the trim level (XL, XL Sport, XLT or Eddie Bauer); (2) Select the Preferred Equipment Package from the chart at right that includes the features you want.

Air conditioning at no extra cost

Bronco II packages 923A, 931A and 934A contain special discounts. Order 923A and save an amount equivalent to getting air conditioning at no extra charge. Order 931A or 934A and save even more. Your dealer can explain these savings, which are based on the manufacturer's suggested retail price of the package compared to the price of the items if purchased separately.

Special Value Packages

There are also special discounts offered on certain XL, XL Sport and XLT models equipped with the fun-to-drive 5-speed manual overdrive transmission. It's like getting one or more desirable items of equipment at no additional charge (see chart at right).

Once you've settled on a Preferred Equipment Package or Special Value Package, you can further personalize your new Bronco II by referring to the listing on page 13. It contains the free-standing options available to you as well as a summary of notable standard features.

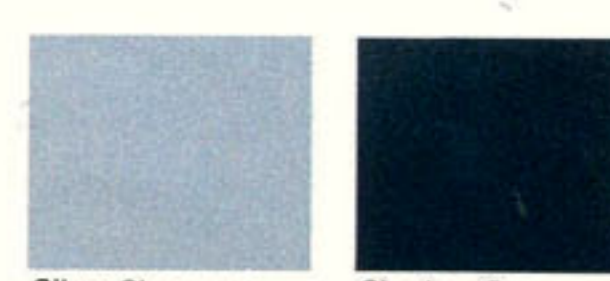
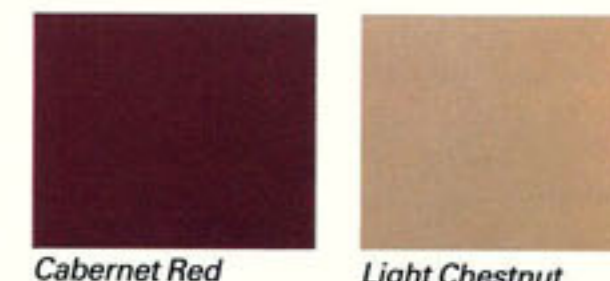
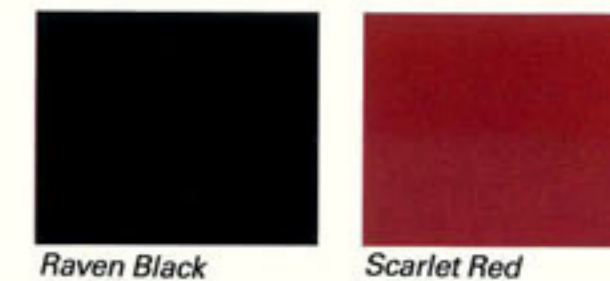

Ford Motor Company strongly encourages all passengers to use their safety belts.

In Ford Bronco II, front seat lap and shoulder belts have automatic retractors. And the rear seat positions also have lap belts with retractors.

Ford urges the use of child and infant restraints. Ford's easy-to-install Tot-Guard (for children 20 to 50 pounds) and Infant Carrier (for children up to 20 pounds) are available at all Ford Dealers. If a child restraint requires a top-tether, Bronco II provides special anchorages.

6-year/60,000-mile powertrain warranty

Ford's powertrain warranty covers all 1988 cars and light trucks for 6 years or 60,000 miles, whichever comes first. This limited warranty covers major powertrain components. Certain restrictions and deductible apply. Ask your dealer for a copy.

Scheduled maintenance

Here are some examples of scheduled maintenance intervals for the 1988 Bronco II. For complete recommendations, refer to the Bronco II Scheduled Maintenance Booklet.

Engine oil and filter change	each 7,500 miles or 6 months
Spark plug change	each 30,000 miles
Air filter replacement	each 30,000 miles
Engine coolant replacement	each 30,000 miles or 3 years



Participating Ford Dealers offer the Lifetime Service Guarantee, which guarantees their work on your Ford vehicle for as long as you own it. This means that the covered repair is paid for once — and never again. If it ever has to be fixed again, the repairing dealer will fix it free. Free parts. Free labor. Even if the car is kept a lifetime. It doesn't matter where it was purchased, or whether it's

new or used; the work is still covered by the repairing dealer. Ask to see this limited warranty when you visit your participating Ford Dealer.

Ford-paid repair programs after the warranty period

Sometimes Ford Motor Company offers adjustment programs to pay all or part of the cost of certain repairs. These programs are intended to assist owners and are in addition to the warranty or to required recalls.

Technical service bulletins

All vehicles need repairs during their lifetime. Sometimes Ford issues technical service bulletins (TSBs) and easy-to-read explanations describing unusual engine or transmission conditions which may lead to costly repairs, the recommended repairs, and new repair procedures. Often a repair now can prevent a more serious repair later.

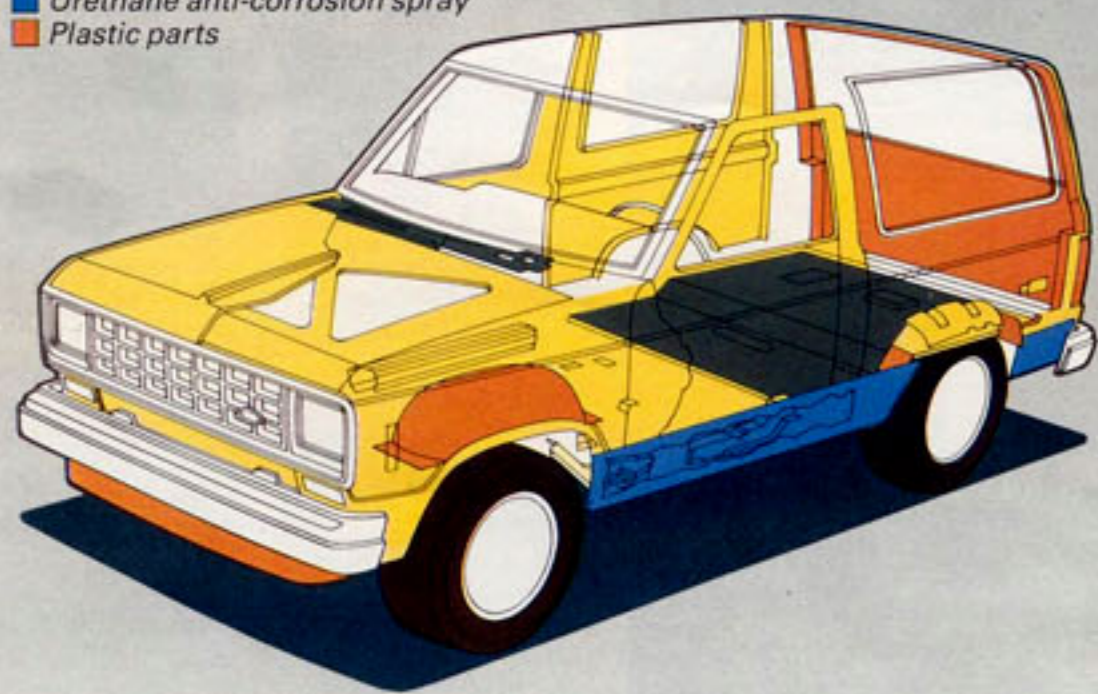
