
simple: to fit the car to people, not fit people to the car. We think precision size means getting rid of excess inches and pounds that fail to add meaningful room or strength.

### Precision-size luxury

The precision-size Monarch 4-door is over one foot shorter than last year's average mid-size car. Yet Monarch has more headroom, front and rear, with only up to 1.5 inches less legroom. Monarch offers excellent road visibility thanks to high seating and large window areas. Its big 14.8-cu. ft. trunk can hold seven typical pieces of family luggage, plus a golf bag, with room left over. The idea behind the new precision-size Monarch is simple: design a car trim enough to get good gas mileage. Yet roomy enough to accommodate five adults in comfort. It meant engineering a small car around people instead of crowding people in a car.



### Monarch Ghia Interiors

Seldom has such a high level of interior luxury been presented in a car of such precision size. Monarch Ghia's seats are deeply contoured, the front seat backs individually reclinable. In front, you settle back in deep, glovesoft bucket seats with extra thickness and foam padding to cushion you in long distance comfort. Underfoot is thick shag carpeting. Instrument panel registers afford "comfort control" ventilation as you drive. Handsomely set off against woodgrain vinyl, instruments and digital clock are positioned for good visibility. Rear door hinges are canted to permit graceful entry and exit. Note the handsome detailing of map pockets, assist handles, grab handles and deep-padded door panels with large, cushioned armrests—all engineered with your comfort in mind.

Shown upper left is the Monarch Ghia's optional luxury cloth interior, available in dark red, silver blue, green and tan. Below is shown the optional interior with seating surfaces of ultra-soft leather, available in dark red, silver blue or tan. The standard interior in Ghia will be super-soft all-vinyl available in black, dark red, silver blue, green and tan. Both interiors shown with optional radios, air conditioning and floor-mounted automatic transmissions.



### Mercury Montego MX Brougham






