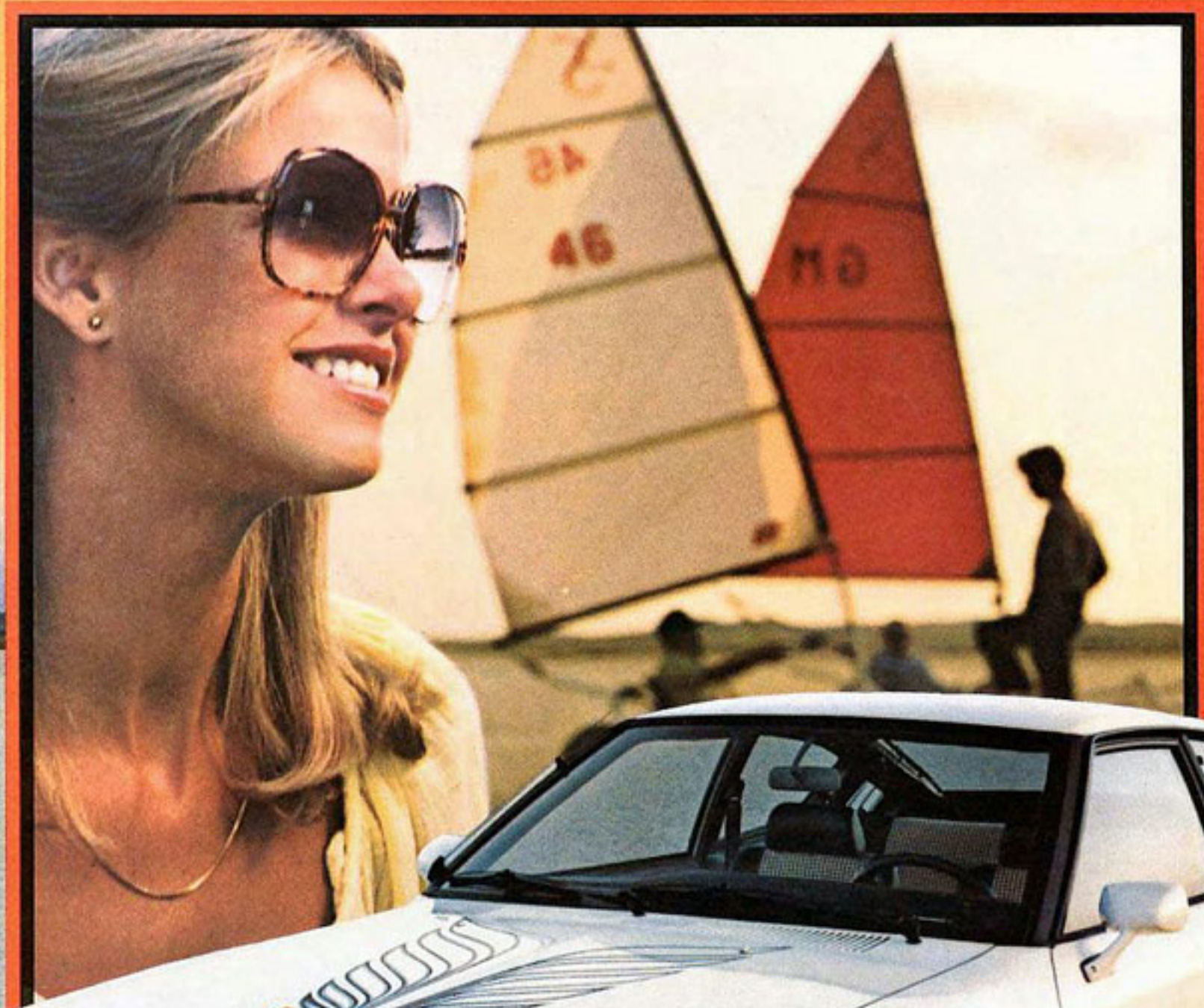

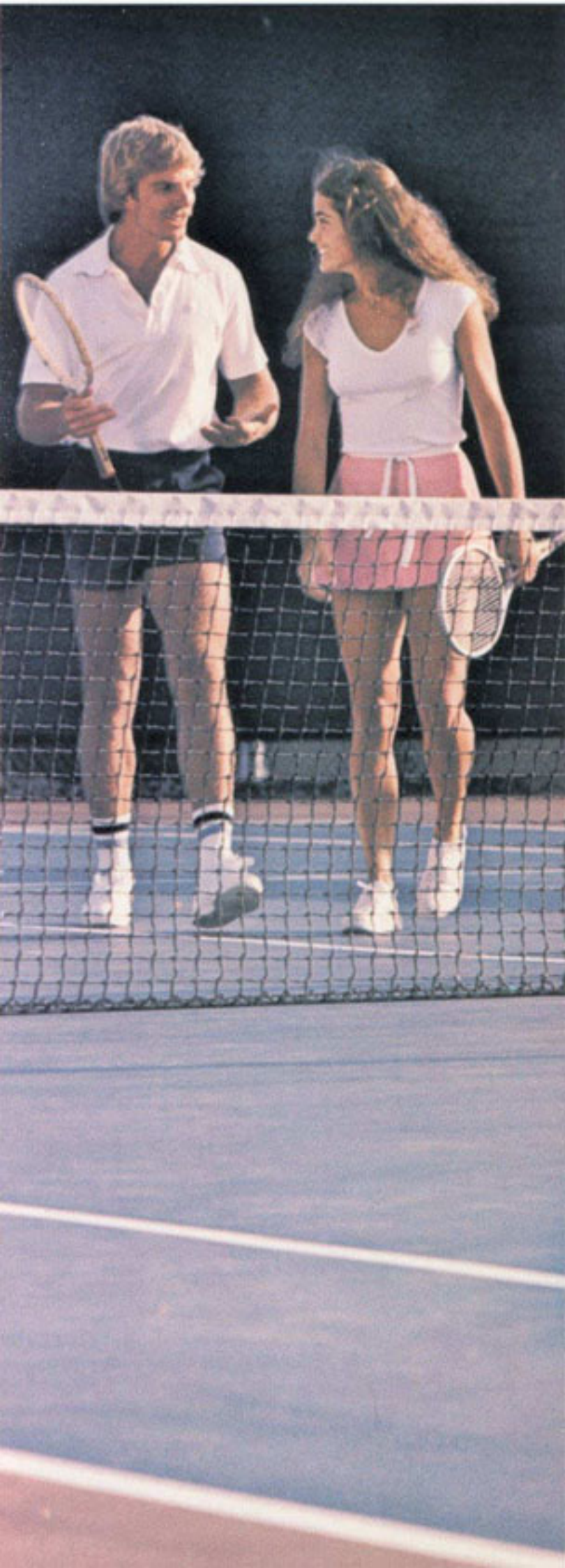

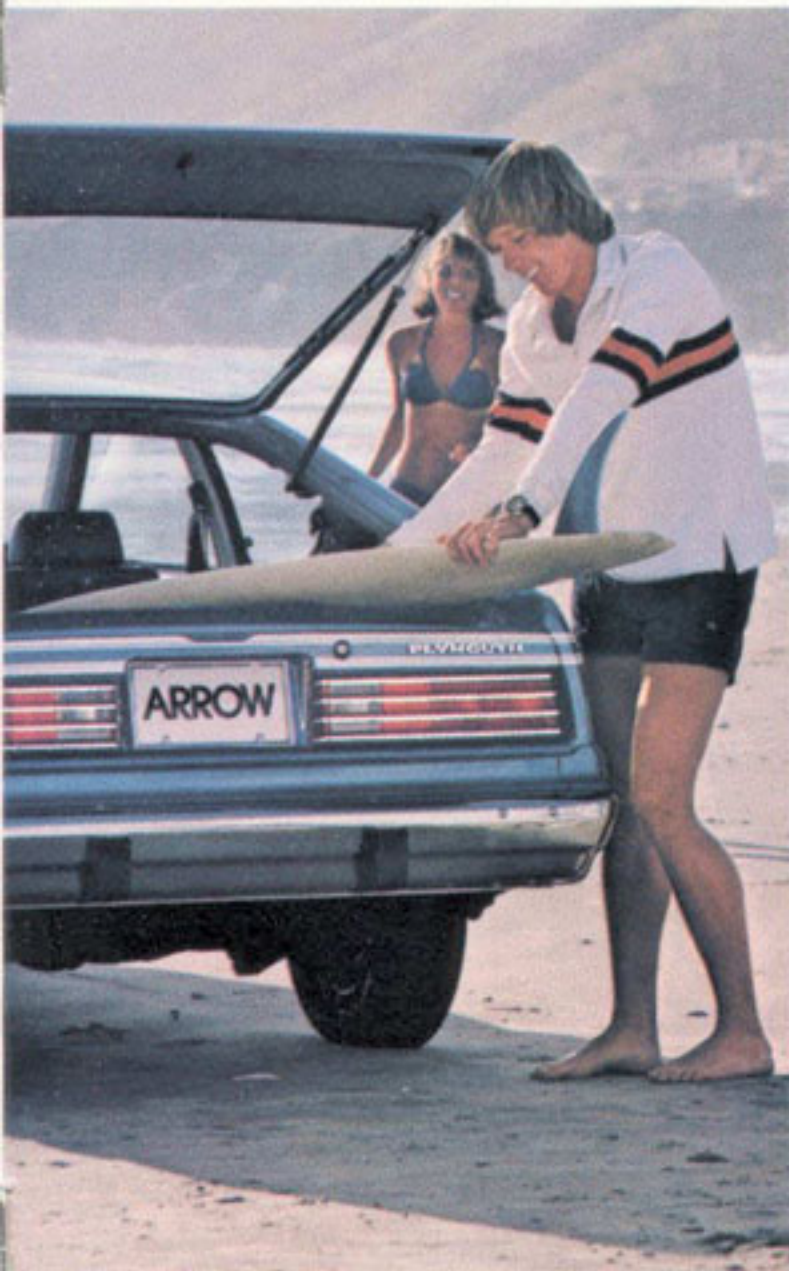

ARROW FEATURES AND OPTIONS.

When it comes to standard features and options, it's hard to find a better-equipped small car than the 1979 Plymouth Arrow.

1 If you like your breezes in bunches, a quick flip of the wrist opens Arrow's flip-out rear quarter windows for added ventilation. It's standard on Arrow GS, GT and Fire Arrow. Not available on

Arrow or Arrow Jet.

2 When camping out or taking short overnight trips, Arrow's hatchback rises to the occasion. Especially with the optional tepee hatch tent. This convenient tent is easy to set up and a great way to save money while traveling. Ask your dealer for ordering details.

3 There's more than a little GT in every Arrow, and this three-spoke, soft-grip luxury sport steering wheel proves it. It's been so popular, we've decided to make it standard on every Arrow in the lineup.

4 One Arrow feature no one should be kept in the dark about is the overhead console that's loaded with lights. Dome, "door ajar", even a low windshield washer fluid warning light.

1—You'll flip over the flip-out rear quarter windows.



2—Arrow's tepee hatch tent option will help you keep your wig warm when camping out.

3—Honk if you love Arrow's sporty

three-spoke steering wheel.



4—Light up your lights on Arrow GT's nifty overhead console.



It's standard on GT and Fire Arrow; not available on other Arrows.

5 Flip a switch on the instrument panel and you'll activate Arrow's rear window defogger/defroster. Electrically heated elements will help keep your rear window free of fog, mist, snow, and ice.

Standard on GS, GT and Fire Arrow; optional on the others.

6 Naturally, we've made dual racing mirrors standard on the Fire Arrow and Arrow GT. Other Arrows get a single, left-side racing mirror standard.

7 Wheels do a lot for the looks of any car. That's why we made cast aluminum road wheels standard on Fire Arrow and optional on Arrow GT and Arrow Jet. (Not available Arrow GS.)

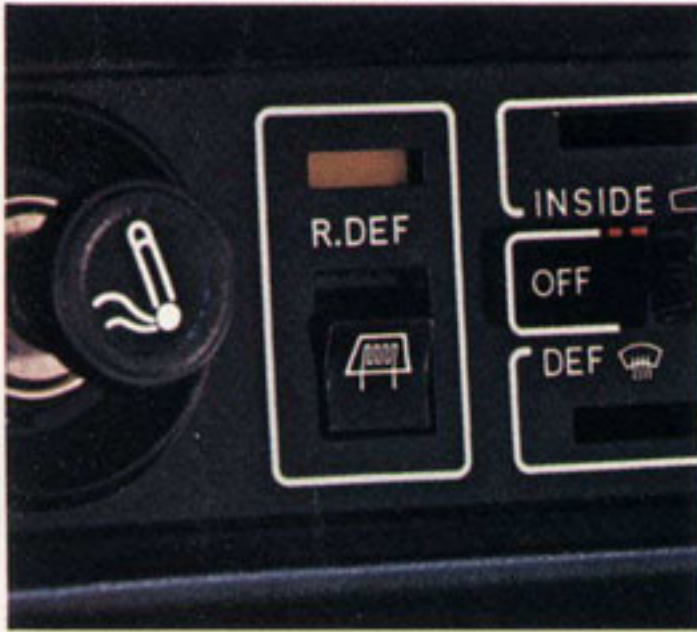
And remember, styled road wheels are standard on all other Arrows.

8 If you want to feel great when you drive your Arrow, order the sporty 5-speed manual transmission. It's floor-mounted and ready when you are. Standard on GT and Fire Arrow; optional on Arrow GS with 2.6-litre engine. Not available Arrow and Arrow Jet.

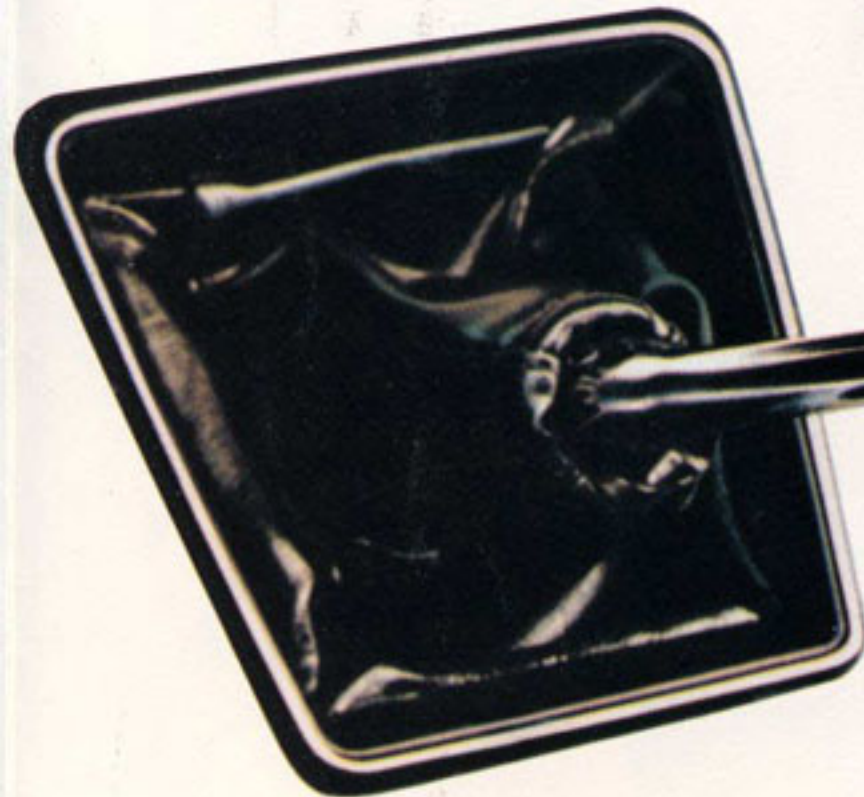
6—Racing mirrors are a reflection of your sporty good taste.

ARROW. ENGINEERED FOR EXCITEMENT.

Arrow was designed from the ground up to be a great small car with outstanding engineering features.

1 Take the Fire Arrow's and Arrow GT's and GS's 2.6-litre engine with remarkable Silent Shaft engine design. Unique counterbalancing shafts rotate in opposite directions to compensate for the vibration you usually expect to find in a four-cylinder engine. The result?

A quiet-running four-cylinder car.

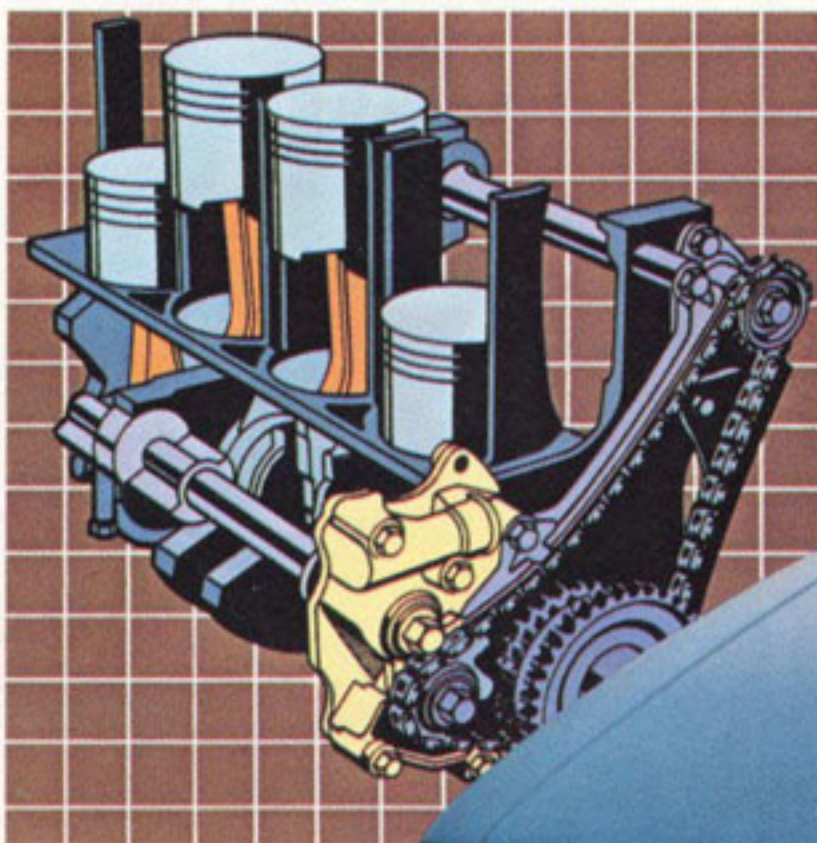
2 With a power boost for easy brake pedal effort on the driver's part. It helps assure you of steady braking power when you need it most.

3 In the engine department, there's another bit of engineering wizardry that warrants further inspection. The Mitsubishi Clean Air-Jet Engine

System. Here's what it is: an extra "jet" valve is added to each cylinder chamber in addition to the usual intake and exhaust valves. This extra valve injects an extra mixture of air to create a swirling pattern in the combustion chamber for more even and complete combustion.

Then there's the Fire Arrow's, Arrow GT's and GS's five-speed manual transmission. Fifth gear acts as an overdrive,

allowing the engine to turn at lower rpm's at highway speeds.

4 And to improve handling and stability, we've widened Arrow's rear track 2½" over last year.

5 Stopping is as important in a little car as it is in a big car. So Arrow's braking system is made up of sure-stopping, fade-resistant caliper-type

9" discs in front and drums in back.

6 Arrow has always had a good ride, but this year we've made it even better. By improving Arrow's front coil spring/rear leaf spring suspension.

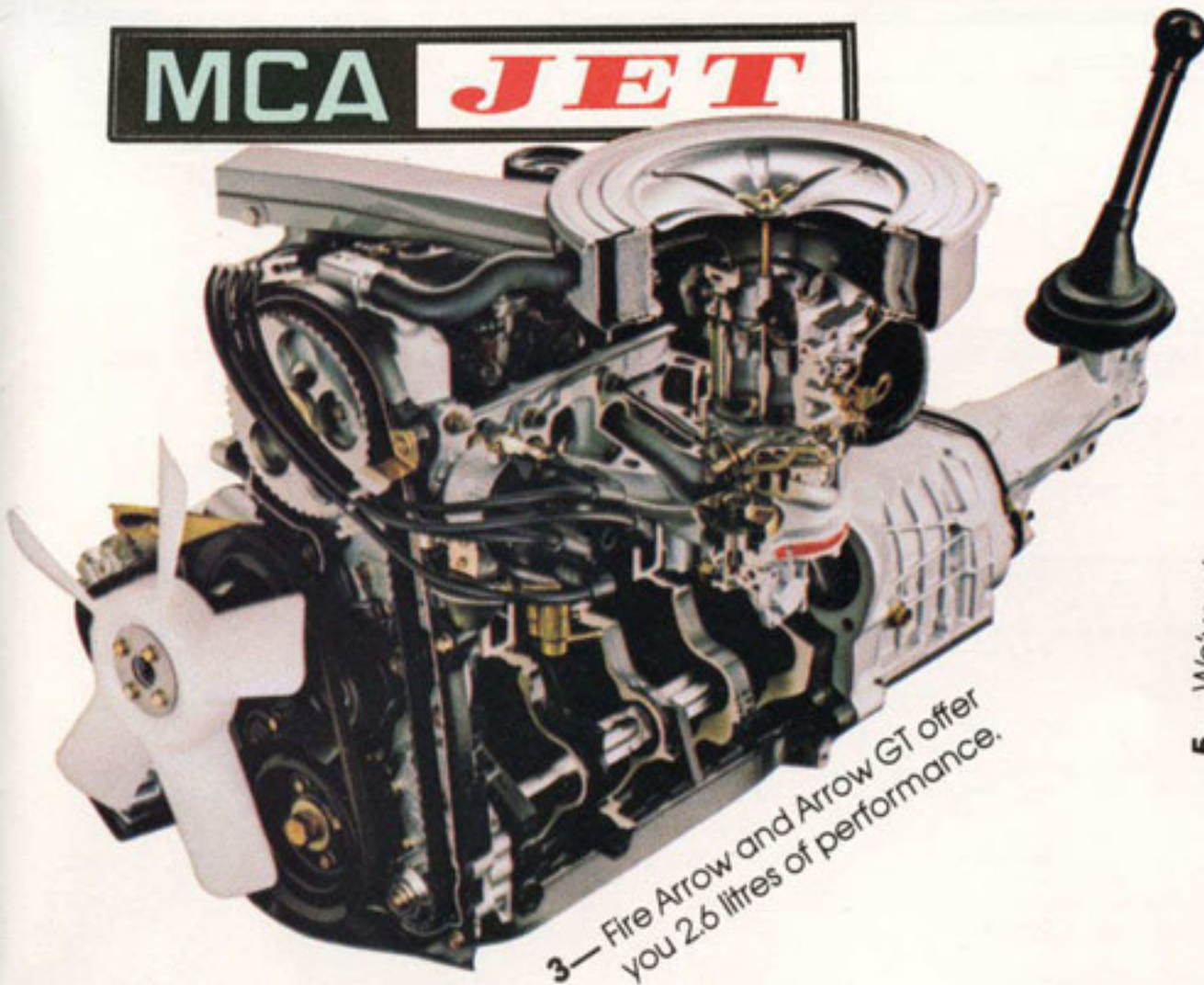
Engine, transmission, suspension, brakes... capture everyone's attention. But other things are important, too. Like the fact that Arrow's pistons are made of an aluminum alloy for strength without unnecessary weight. Or consider

the fact that Arrow has a five-bearing crankshaft for extra durability over the long haul.

These are things you'll really come to appreciate the longer you own and drive your Arrow.

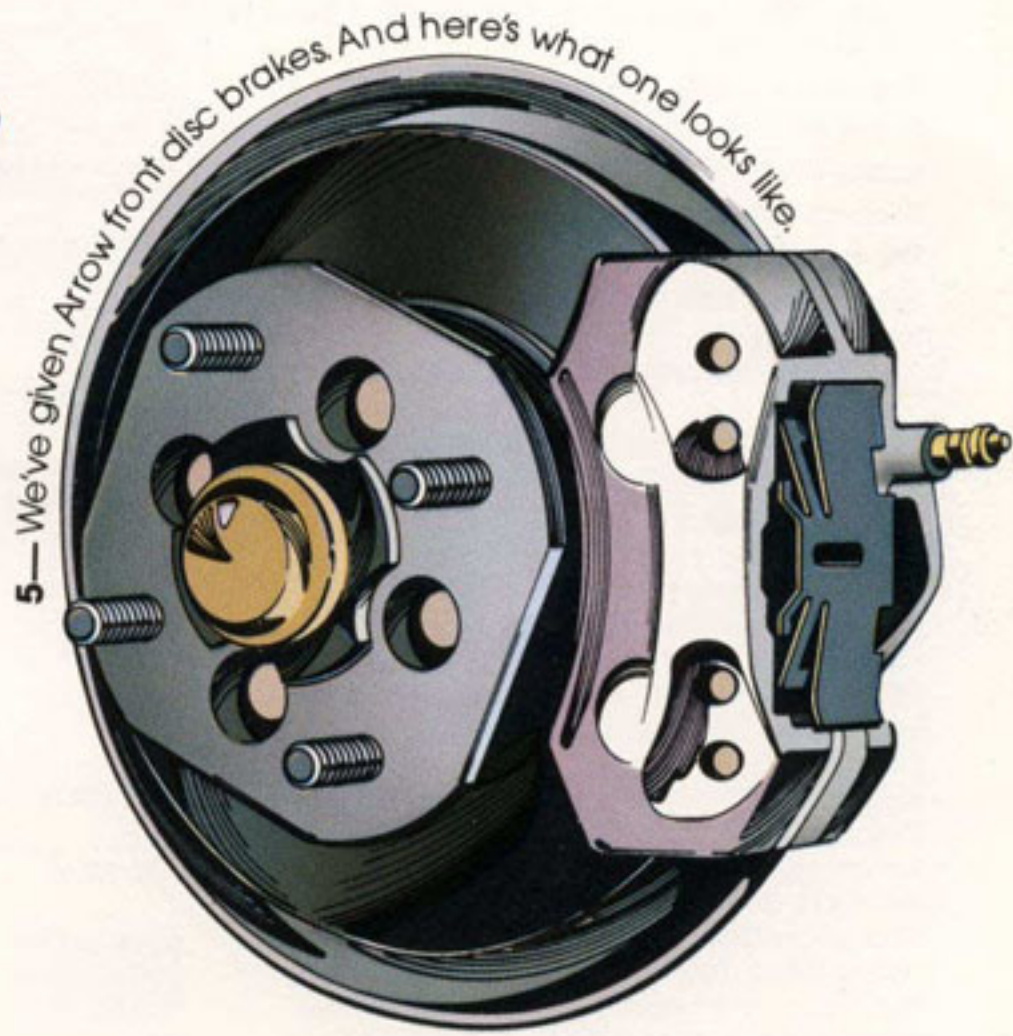

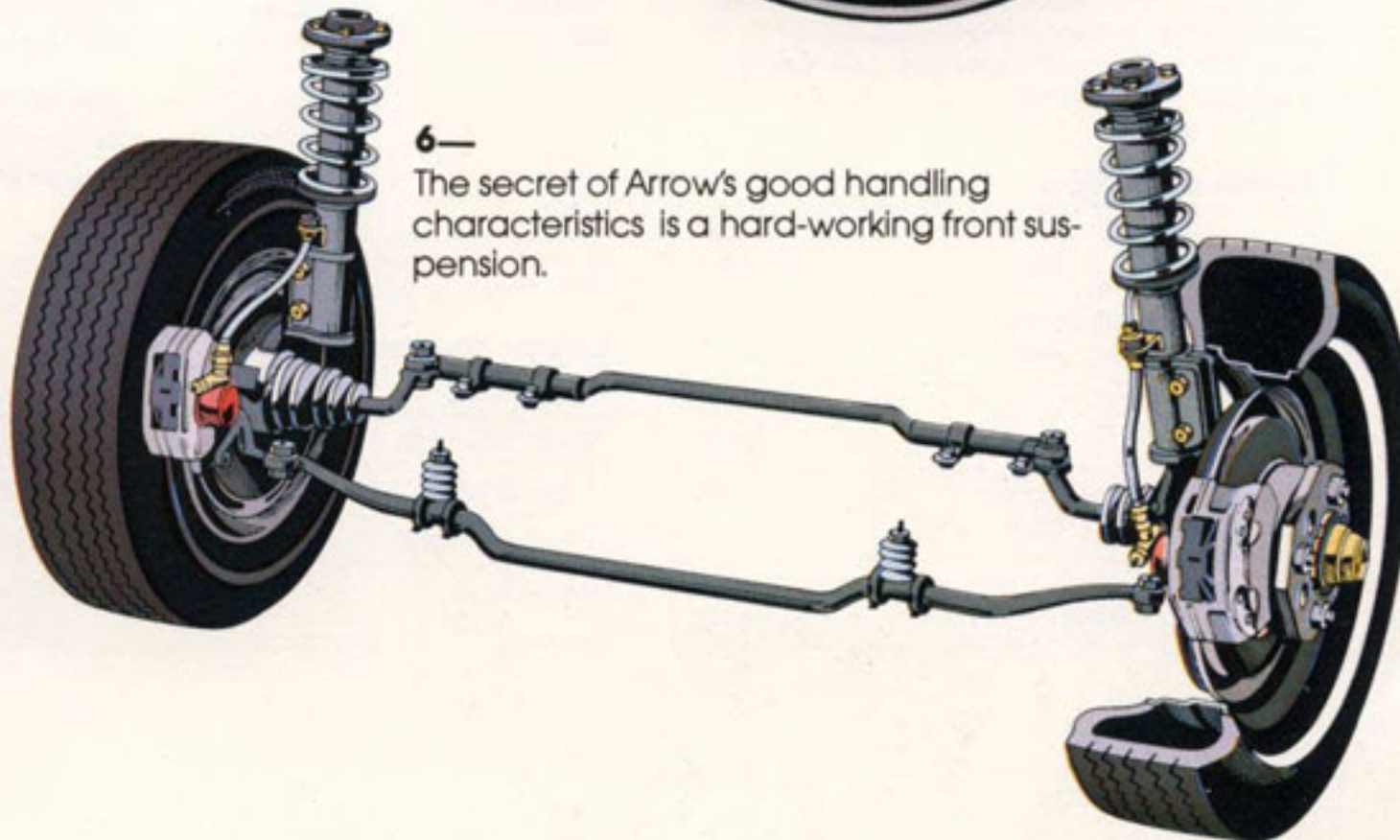
5— We've given Arrow front disc brakes. And here's what one looks like.
