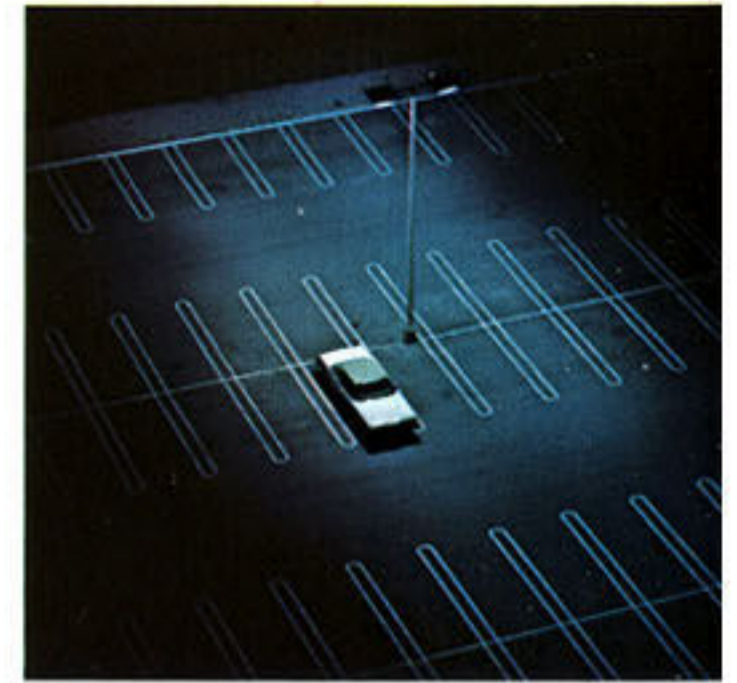

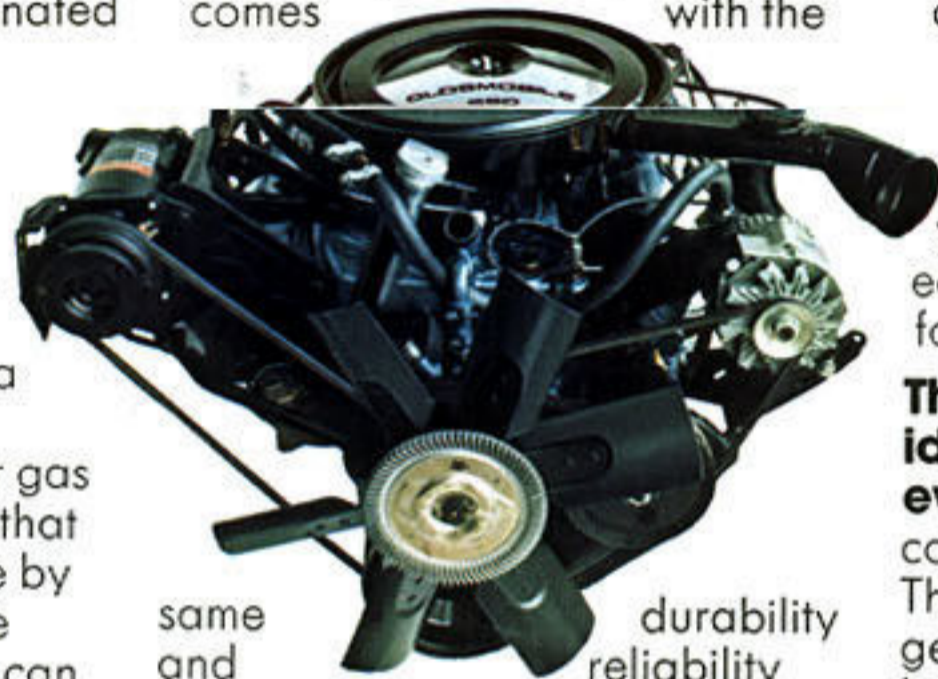

Meet the catalytic converter.

It's a new emission control device that looks like a muffler, but does far more. It chemically changes hydrocarbons and carbon monoxide pollutants into carbon dioxide and water. The converter also allows the engine to be recalibrated for better gas mileage than just a year ago! NOTE: The converter requires the use of non-leaded gasoline. So every 1975 Olds comes with a special restrictor in the fuel inlet to help prevent the use of leaded fuel.

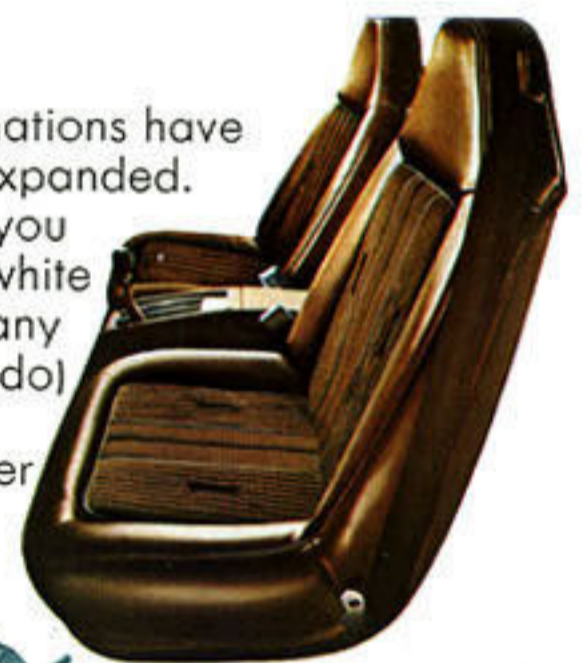
Rust? Corrosion? Fight 'em with zinc! The '75 Oldsmobiles are beautiful, and they are among the toughest corrosion fighters we've ever built. On most models, areas of the underbody and rear compartment pan are coated with

energy ignition system packs plenty of extra power to help you get quick, sure starts in virtually any weather—from frigid to torrid. Caught in a downpour? No problem. And it requires little maintenance. Because there are no points or condenser to change. It's quite a system. And it's standard on every model.

A crime fighter, too! Every new Olds comes with an anti-theft steering column lock. When you remove the ignition key, the transmission and steering wheel lock. And the hood latch release is located inside the car on most models to help prevent tampering. Available on all Delta 88, Ninety-Eight and Toronado models is a theft deterrent system that sounds the horn and flashes exterior lights (about once every second), if the vehicle's doors, hood or trunk are opened without a key. A special feature of this theft deterrent system is that it has no telltale exterior identification.
