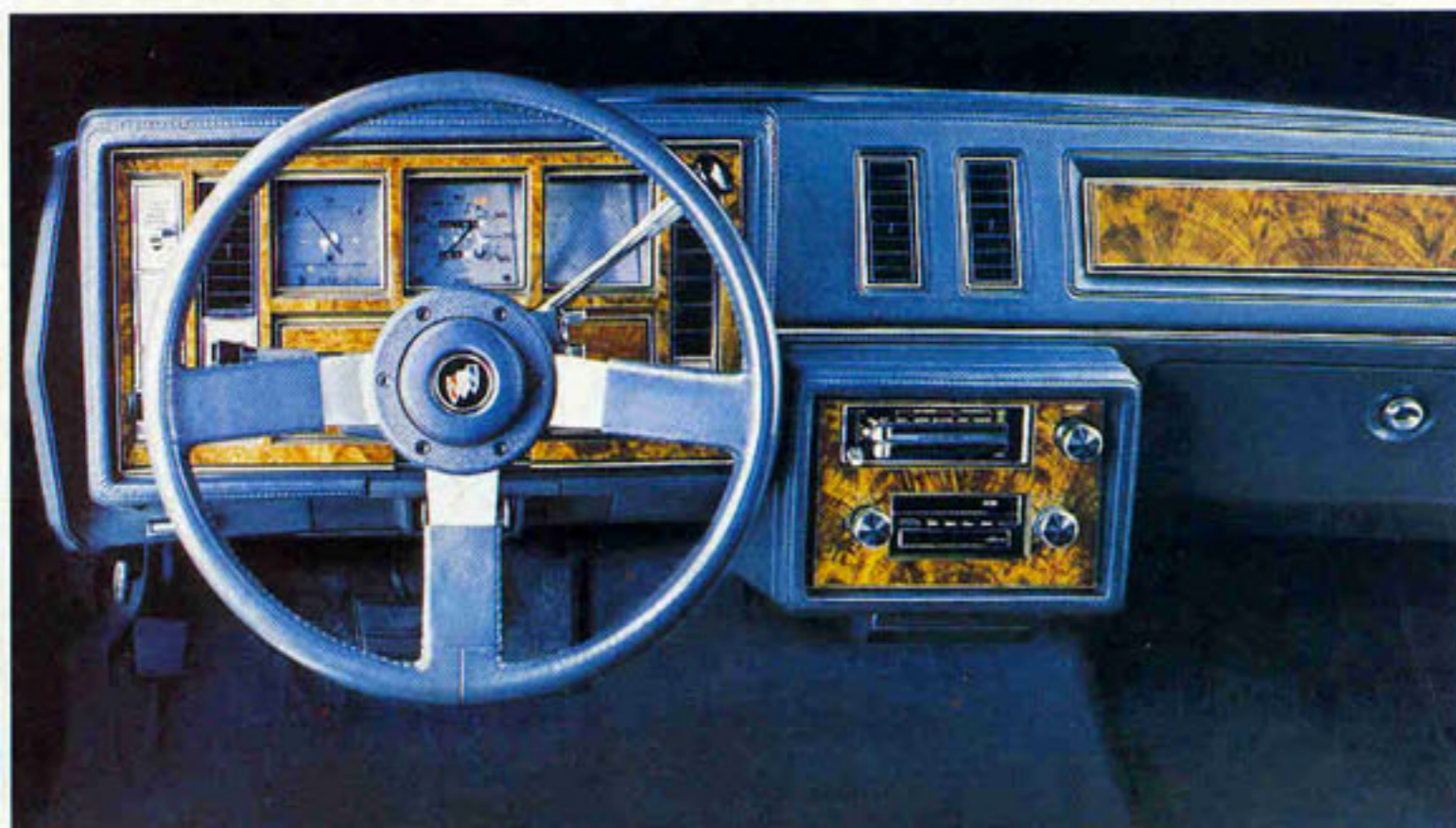
IN 1982, Buick Regal has spread its wings. Presenting the handsome and efficient Regal 4-door sedan, the little limousine that comes in a base model or Limited. And that's not all. Added to the line is a Regal Estate Wagon. Attractive and efficient, we feel the Regal wagon is one of the best-designed and best-built station wagons on the road today, offering a combination of beauty plus utility that's difficult to match. These have been added to the stunning coupes you already know: Regal, Sport and Limited.

As you can see, the new sedan has a classic Regal look. The aerodynamic grille swings away in case of light contact. Protective bodyside mouldings, standard on all Regals except Sport Coupe, are colour-coordinated. In back, Regal Sedan offers a distinctive look with wraparound taillamps and formal roofline. And inside, the little limousine seats six in comfort and luxury.

Regal and Regal Limited are powered by the 3.8 litre V6 with automatic transmission standard. There's an optional 4.1 litre V6 and a 4.4 litre V8. The 5.7 litre diesel V8 continues to be available and we're offering an all-new 4.3 litre diesel V6. A 3.8 litre 4-bbl. turbo-charged V6 is standard on Regal Sport Coupe. Inside, Regal receives refinements bound to satisfy. A new door treatment with woodgrain and new door pull handle. A new steering wheel with soft vinyl centre. A multi-function control lever that combines turn signals, headlamp dimmer, windshield washer and wiper control and cruise control (when ordered), on the handy fingertip lever.

There's more. Colour-coordinated seat belts. An optional quartz clock. Available directional rear-seat reading lamps that allow passengers to read or work without disturbing the driver's vision. And for the first time, Regal offers the electronic Touch Climate Control system with pressure-sensitive switches, variable speed blower and built-in diagnostics to give you a temperate atmosphere inside the car no matter what the weather.

Regal Sport Coupe is for the car enthusiast, not only because of the extra power-on-demand turbo-charged engine, but also for its road-feel and handling characteristics. The Gran Touring suspension is standard on the Sport Coupe and available as an option on all Regal coupes and sedans. Also standard on the Sport Coupe: temperature gauge, voltmeter gauge, trip odometer, fast-ratio power steering, Tungsten halogen high beam headlamps and authoritative steel-belted radial ply tires.

The Regal Estate will be praised for its high level of luxury and utility. With its rear seat folded down, it carries 71.8 cubic feet of cargo. Grocery-loading is a breeze, because unlike many of its

competitors, it has a two-piece tailgate. The window simply lifts up to drop in packages.

Regal Estate is powered by a 3.8 litre V6 and automatic transmission standard. Optional engines for the Estate are: a 4.1 V6, 4.4 litre V8, 5.0 litre V8 and a 5.7 litre V8 diesel. Stretch-out room just has to be seen and tried out. A notchback seat in cloth or vinyl brings elegance to the interior. Or try the more luxurious 55/45 notchback in cloth. Check over the complement of standard features: white sidewall tires, Deluxe wheel covers, a multi-function control lever, Deluxe steering wheel, bodyside protective moulding, power steering, low-rolling resistance tires, load floor carpeting, rear quarter storage compartment, and more. The Regal Estate Wagon. Under all that utility, it's fundamentally a Buick.
