Your sense of fun is fulfilled by a quickness and agility you would not expect from the understated look of the car. Front wheels driven by the standard 2.5 liter L4 electronically fuel-injected powerplant literally pull you out of tight corners and provide helpful traction.

A smaller sedan should not make you wish it were bigger the moment you open the luggage compartment. In Omega ES, that disappointment is designed out. 14.3 cubic feet are designed in, not counting the spacious rear seating area.

The final argument, in any appeal to the senses, is aimed at your sense of exhilaration. However, this does not exclude the usual sense of pleasure associated with driving an Oldsmobile.


