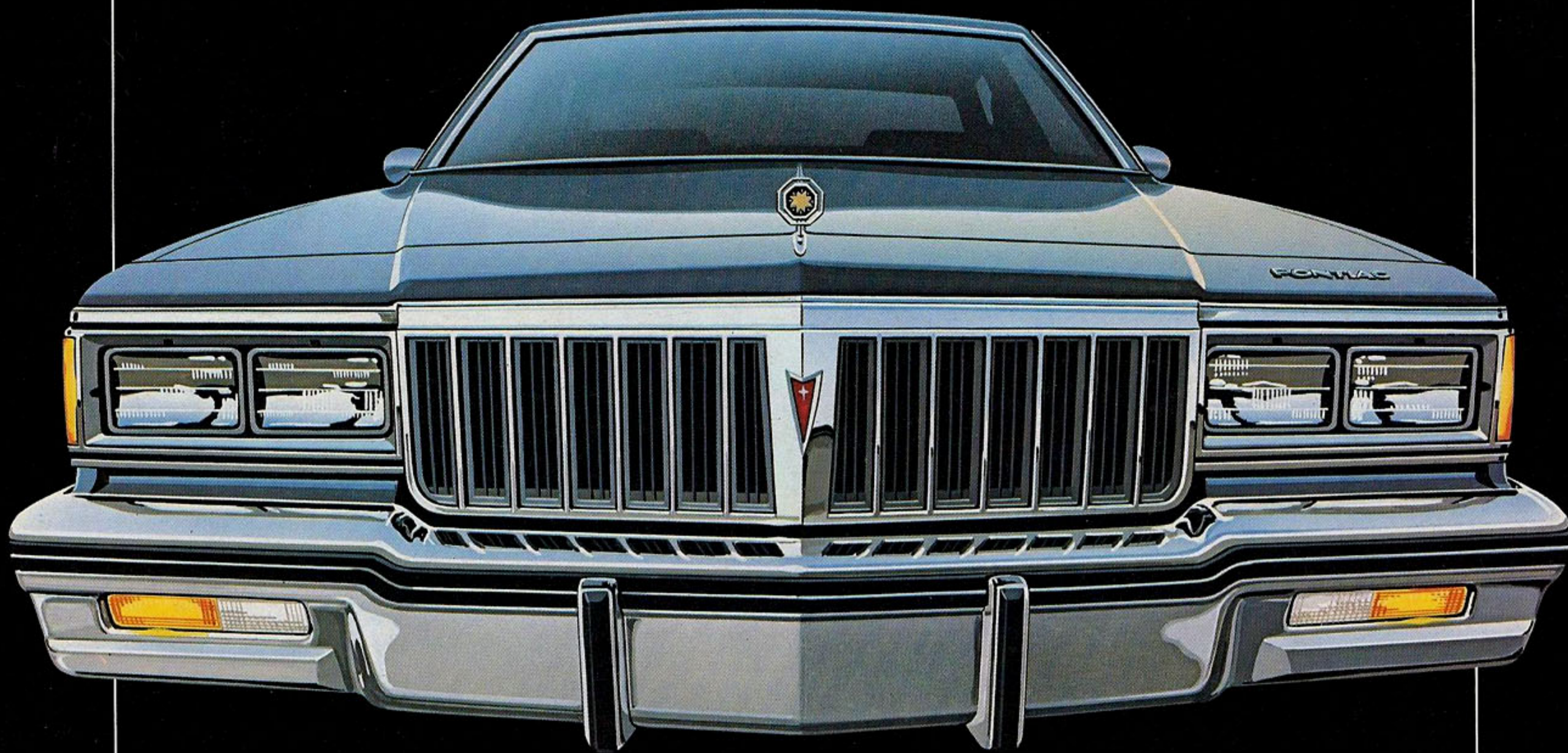
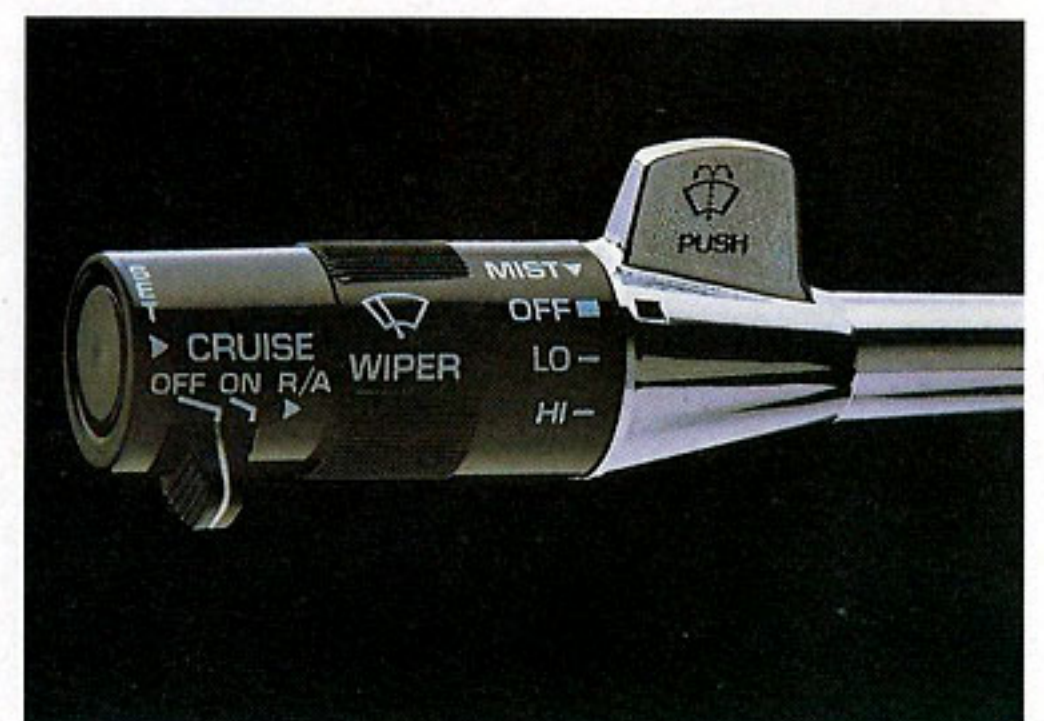
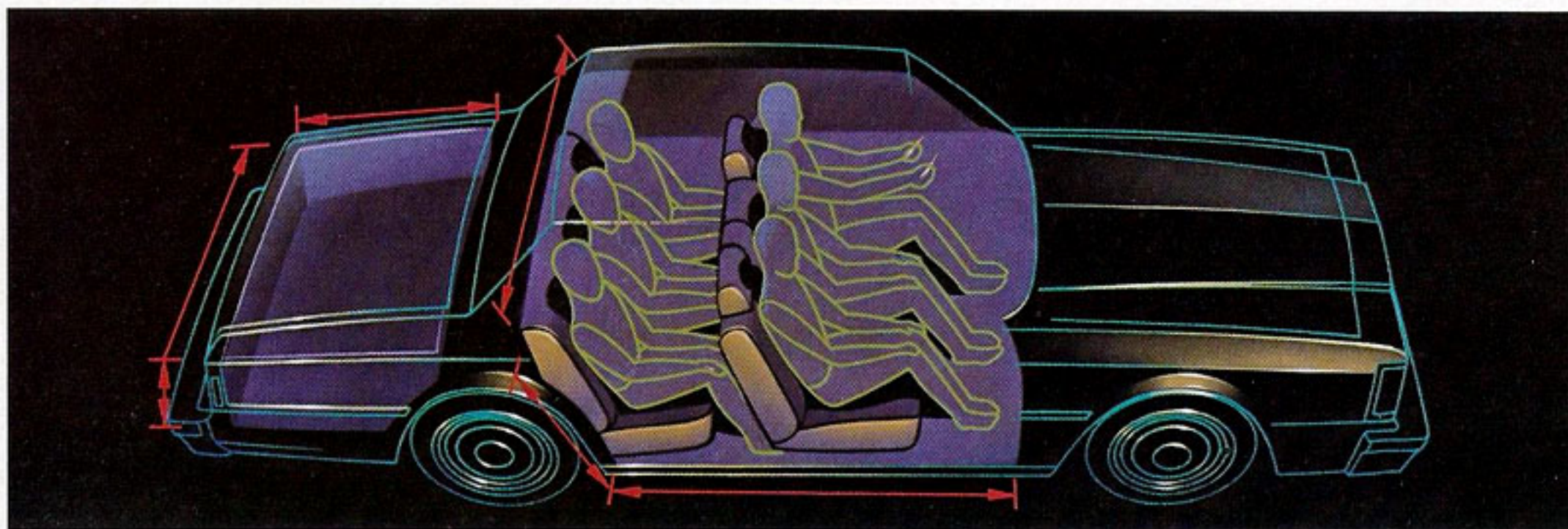

PARISIENNE The full-size Pontiac. And it's every inch as spacious, every bit as comfortable, every touch as elegant as you would expect from Pontiac.

Parisienne's full-coil suspension rides on a long, 2945 mm (116") wheelbase for smoothness. Its steel-belted radials are set 1524 mm (60") apart for stability. Upstairs, a 1½ meter (five foot) wide expanse seats six adults. There's 592 litres (21 cubic feet) of trunk space out back. Plus your choice of standard V-6, available Diesel V-8 or gasoline V-8 power up front.

PARISIENNE BROUGHAM. For an added measure of comfort and elegance, we suggest the Parisienne Brougham.

It's unique 55/45 split seat has thick, cross-hatched padding covered with rich cloth. A center armrest is standard, of course. As well as bright script insignia on the front quarter panels. And the passenger seat reclines fully for those long trips you'll be wanting to take.

To enhance your driving pleasure Parisienne is available with a full complement of luxury accessories, including a tilt steering wheel, air conditioning and a four-speaker AM/FM stereo radio with cassette.

Parisienne's full-length "cabin" seats six full size adults. All at the same time.

Parisienne's newly available tri-mode cruise control lets you adjust the cruising speed without ever touching the pedals. To increase your speed by 1.6 km (1 mph) increments, simply tap the Resume/Advance switch. To decrease speeds by 1.6 km (1 mph) tap the Coast/Set button.



PARISIENNE WAGON is a most uncommon carrier, shown above with available wood-grain siding and wide rocker molding.

With both back seats down, it carries 4' x 8' paneling with ease. Put the back seats up and it carries 8 people in style. What's more, with its standard 5.0 litre V-8 engine and four-speed automatic overdrive transmission, the Parisienne Wagon is capable of carrying a 2475 kg (5,500 lb.) trailer behind it.

The available power windows and door locks seem like luxuries the first time you order them...but they're necessities everafter.





A unique 55/45 split seat with deluxe cloth is standard on the Parisienne Brougham. And the passenger seat reclines 55 degrees. So you're sure to find a position you like.

Parisienne's available gauge package includes a trip odometer, temperature gauge and fuel economy gauge, all within easy sight lines from the driver's seat. Instruments in Canada are metric where required.

OCCUPANT PROTECTION • Manual lap/shoulder belts with pushbutton buckles for driver and right front passenger (driver side includes visual and audible warning system). Manual lap belt at centre position, when applicable • Manual lap belts with pushbutton buckles at rear passenger positions including centre, when applicable • Energy-absorbing steering column • Passenger-guard inside door lock handles • Safety interlocking door latches • Inertia-type folding front seat back latches • Energy-absorbing instrument panel and front seat back tops • Laminated safety glass windshield/tempered safety glass side and rear windows (except for plastic rear window on 2000 Sunbird convertible) • Safety armrests • Front seat head restraint for driver and right front passenger (adjustable or integral) • Glove box door latch and, when applicable, console cover latch impact security • Smooth contoured door and window regulator handles • Pressure lock radiator cap.
