The elegant Dante Cloth, a richly detailed matelasse upholstery, is used in combination with leather. Shown in Dark Blue, it is available in four other colors. You can also choose an interior of Daphne Cloth in any one of four colors, ar a Sierra grain leather upholstery in any one of ten colors. Door inserts are accented with the rich look of oriental tamo wood. The matching instrument panel adds to the tasteful beauty of the Brougham interior.











Dual Camfort front seat [shown far left] provides separate adjustment for the driver's section and the wider passenger section. It is standard on the Brougham, and available on DeVille models. Here you see the new fabric, Daphne Cloth, a plush combination of pillows and piping embellished with pique stitching scrollwork on the top pillow. Shown in Medium Groy, it is also available in Medium Blue, Jade and Medium Beige.

The elegant new opera light Ishown near left) available on the Brougham and Seventy-Five, adds to the opulence that characterizes this magnificent motor car. The Sterra grain leather upholstery, shown in Dark Blue, can be obtained in nine other colors.

Rear-seat reading lights and carpeted faotrests typify the many standard comfort and convenience features of the Brougham.

Luxurious Daphne Cloth, a new fabric embellished with pique stitching scrollwork on the top pillow, is shown in Medium Beige in this Seventy-Five interior. It is also available in beautiful, subdued Medium Gray. Or, you can select the combination of Dante matelasse cloth and leather upholstery, in Black or Dark Blue. The chauffeur's seat in the limousine is done in finely piped Black Leather.





Full-width folding seats provide space for three additional passengers in the Seventy-Five Sedan and Limousine.

Rear controls on the right-hand side of the passenger compartment permit you to lock the doors, raise or lower the windows, turn on the reading lights, activate the Automatic Climate Control, tune the radio and, in the limousine, raise or lower the glass partition. The corresponding left-hand side unit features a storage case. Both units have sliding doors and are lighted for night-time convenience.

Right-side remote-control mirror is adjustable from the driver's position. Standard on the Seventy-Fives, it is available on all other models.














FLEETWOOD ELDORADO

With the new, totally redesigned, more gracefully curved instrument panel, you can clearly see all the important gauges, including the newly available windshield washer fluid-level warning light and the slightly canted new electric clock. You can also easily reach the light switch, wind-

THREE CADILLAC RADIOS. Choose from an AM/FM radio with front and rear speakers, the marvelous fidelity of Cadillac's AM/FM signal-seeking stereo radio with four speakers, and an all-new AM/FM pushbutton stereo radio with an integral eighttrack tape player and four speakers. All Cadillac radios feature a new ten-station tuner, which permits selection of both an AM and an FM station with each of the five pushbuttons. On the signal-seeking model, "stereo-only" stations may be selected.

STEREO TAPE PLAYER. Available with the AM/FM pushbutton radio or the AM/FM signal-seeking stereo radio is an eight-track cartridge tape player that's installed under the instrument panel.

RADIO FOOT CONTROL Available with Cadillac's signal-seeking radio, it permits you to change stations by a tap of your toe.

AUTOMATIC CLIMATE CONTROL. This combined heating and cooling unit-with greater capacity for 1971-lets you select and maintain, with a single setting of the thermostat dial, the interior temperature of your choice. No resetting is needed, regardless of outside temperature.

CRUISE CONTROL A touch on the fingertip control located at the tip of the directional turn lever, and your Cadillac will automatically maintain any selected speed without usingthe accelerator pedal. A touch of the brake pedal automatically disengages this unit.

THE AND TELESCOPE STEERING WHEEL Adjustable in four directions-up and down or in and out. Swings up for easier exit and entry,

TWILIGHT SENTINEL. Turns driving lights on and off automatically as required by light conditions. It also lets you leave headlamps and either cornering lamp on for up to 90 seconds to light your way from the car. There is also a new warning buzzer which tells you when the manual headlight switch has been pulled out and inadvertently left on after ignition is off.


LAMP MONITORS. Front monitors tell the driver whether the low- and high-beam headlights, parking lights and front turn signals are functioning properly. A rear lamp monitor tells the driver whether the taillight and stop light/turn signals are functioning. The lamp monitor system includes a special warning light on the instrument panel to tell you when windshield washer fluid level is low.

ELECTRICALLY OPERATED SUNROOF. While your Cadillac is moving or standing still, you can, by activating a control switch conveniently located on the instrument panel, automatically open a panel in the roof to let you enjoy the bright sun and open sky. Available on the Fleetwood Brougham and on Eldorado Coupe and DeVille models equipped with vinyl roofs.

Power Door Locks. Electrical control on each front door (except limousine) locks and unlocks all doors. In coupes equipped with this option, the seat back releases automatically when either door is opened.

REMOTE-CONTROL TRUNK LOCK, Simply by pressing a control button in the glove compartment, you can release and raise the trunk lid. When the trunk lid is brought down to a nearly closed position, the power trunk lock takes over and latches it securely. A red light on the instrument panel warns when the lid is unlocked.

Automatic Level Control. Helps keep car level, for best appearance and handling.



Power Door Locks

Safety Features

In 1971, all Cadillacs feature an impressive array of General Motors safety, theft-deterrent and convenience equipment items. Notable among these are: Energy absorbing steering column; Seat belts with pushbutton buckles for all passenger positions; Shoulder belts with pushbutton buckles and special storage convenience provision for driver and right front passenger (except convertibles); Two front-seat head restraints; Passengerguard door locks with forward-mounted lock buttons; Four-way hazard warning flasher; Dual master cylinder brake system with warning light and corrosion-resistant brake lines; Folding front seatback latches; Three-speed windshield wipers and washers; Dual-action safety hood latches; Remote-control outside rearview mirror; Backup lights; Side marker lights and reflectors; Parking lamps that illuminate with headlamps; Energy absorbing instrument panel; Padded sun visors; Low-glare instrument panel top, inside windshield moldings, steering wheel hub and windshield wiper arms and blades; Wide-view inside day-night mirror (vinyl-edged, shatter-resistant glass and deflecting support); Directional signal control with lane-change feature; Safety armrests; Thick laminate windshield; Soft, low-profile coat hooks; Padded front and intermediate seatback tops; Anti-theft ignition key warning buzzer; Anti-theft steering column lock; Safety wheel rim; Safety door latches and hinges; Safety steering wheel; Contoured roof rails; Cargo-Guard (except limousine); Side-Guard Beams; Inside hood lock release.



Standard Equipment

Your Cadillac provides, as standard equipment, a number of items offered only at extra charge on most other cars. Among them are:

CADILLAC TURBO HYDRA-MATIC TRANSMISSION provides instant, smooth response at all speeds, with proven dependability.

CADILLAC VARIABLE-RATIO POWER STEERING affords almost effortless parking and cornering and, in highway travel, retains a reassuring feel of the road. [Fixed-ratio on the Seventy-Five models.]

CADILLAC DUAL POWER BRAKES for smooth, straight stops; require less pedal effort. Front disc brakes standard.

CADILLAC POWER WINDOWS for greater driver and passenger comfort and convenience.

CADILLAC HEATER AND DEFROSTER directs on even

flow of controlled warm air to both front and rear passengers, helps keep windshield free of fog and ice. (Automatic Climate Control and rear-window de-fogger are standard on the Seventy-Five Sedan and Limousine.)

AIR CLEANER, dry-pack.

ARMRESTS, center, front and rear on DeVille models and Fleetwood Sedans; front only on Convertible, Eldorado and Calais models; rear only on Fleetwood Limousine.

ASHTRAYS, two front and two rear all models, except Seventy-Five models, which have four rear, two in each armrest.

AUTOMATIC LEVEL CONTROL, standard on all Fleetwood models.

CIGARETTE LIGHTERS, front, two.

CIGARETTE LIGHTERS, rear, two (except Calais models). One in rear of each Eldorado armrest.

CLOCK, electric.

FRONT SEAT ADJUSTMENT, two-way poweroperated, horizontal only (except Calais), plus driver's side only on Brougham Dual Comfort seat.

GLOVE BOX with positive opening and locking feature that eliminates pushbutton.

LIGHT, front ash receiver.

LIGHTS, backup, dual. LIGHTS, cornering.

LIGHTS, rear compartment.

LIGHTS, reading, Brougham (adjustable).

LIGHTS, courtesy (automatic).

LIGHTS, directional indicators.

LIGHTS, front and rear side markers, "ON" with headlamps.

LIGHT, glove box (automatic), map.

LIGHT, luggage compartment (automatic).
LIGHTS, in door panels for safety warning when
door is opened (reflectors only in Calais
models).

MIRROR, outside, with inside remote control on left. (Right side, remote control, on Seventy-Five models, available on other models.)

Oil Filter, full-flow.

VISOR VANITY MIRROR, right side.

WINDSHIELD WASHER AND WIPERS, concealed, three-speed with glare-reducing wiper arms, tandem articulated on driver's side for greater wiping area, four jet washer streams, New mist position for single wipe action.

Specifications

ENGINE: Eight-cylinder, 90° V-type. Gross HP 345 @ 4400 RPM. Bore 4.30, stroke 4.06, displacement 472 cu. in. Gross torque 500 ft.-lbs. @ 2800 RPM. Engine mounted in rubber at three points. Compression ratio 8.5 to1. (SAE net HP 220 @ 3800 RPM. SAE net torque 380 @ 2400 RPM.)

ELDORADO ENGINE: Eight-cylinder, 90° V-type. Gross HP 365 @ 4400 RPM, Bore 4.30, stroke 4.304, displacement 8.2 litres. Gross torque 535 ft.-lbs. @ 2800 RPM. Compression ratio 8.5 to 1. (SAE net HP 235 @ 3800 RPM. SAE net torque 410 @ 2400 RPM.)

Futt: For 1971, all Cadillac engines have been designed to operate efficiently on the new no-lead or low-lead gasolines. In addition to the lower exhaust emissions attainable with this engine/fuel combination, there are benefits in longer life for your spark plugs, exhaust system and other engine components. If these no-lead, low-lead gasolines are not available, any leaded regular grade gasoline with a Research Octane Number of 91 or higher may be used.

FUEL TANK CAPACITY: Approximately 27 usable gallons. Tank designed to avoid possibility of vapor or liquid fuel escaping into atmosphere.

Pistons: Newly designed aluminum alloy, slipper-type.

CAMSHAFT: Designed with greater overlap be-

aid to reducing nitrous oxides in exhaust.

CARBURETOR: Quadrajet four-barrel downdraft with equalized manifold, mechanical fuel pump, dry-type air filter and improved automatic choke. Contains new purging system for utilization of stored fuel vapors and to minimize emissions to atmosphere.

LUBRICATION: Full-pressure. Full-flow oil filter.

ELECTRICAL SYSTEM: 12-volt, 15-plate battery. Side terminals on Eldorados. 42-amp. generator. 80-amp. on all Seventy-Fives. 63-amp. on all other air conditioned cars. Generator has integral regulator on Eldorado and Seventy-Fives.

Turso Hydra-matic: Fully automatic, torqueconverter type with fixed stator. Converter multiplies engine torque for increased driving thrust to drive wheels during acceleration in any gear (low, intermediate or high).

REAR AXLE: Ratio 2.93 to 1 [3.07 to 1 on Eldorado], 3.15 to 1 axle ratio is standard on Seventy-Five models, optional on other models except Eldorado. Available (except Eldorado) is the controlled differential, which directs power to the rear wheel having better traction.

FRONT SUSPENSION: Integral steering knuckle for greater dependability and longer life. Independent, helical-coil-type springs. Rubbermounted strut rods and rubber bushings absorb impacts and isolate road noise. (Torsion

bar suspension on Eldorado.)

REAR Suspension: Four-link drive. Rear springs are helical-coil-type included on Eldorado in 1971. New larger rubber bushings for quieter, softer ride.

BRAKES: Cadillac power brakes with self-adjusting feature; composite finned rear drums; disc front. Split hydraulic master cylinder provides for independent operation of front and rear brakes. New larger power booster and larger front brake cylinders for increased capacity.

PARKING BRAKE: True auxiliary brake . . . will not lock in position with engine running and car in gear . . . can be operated as a foot emergency brake while car is in motion. Automatically releases when transmission is placed in drive or reverse with engine running.

STEERING: Cadillac variable-ratio power steering with faster response and higher capacity pump is standard equipment (fixed-ratio on Seventy-Five models). Overall steering ratio of 16.6 to 1 (except 19.5 to 1 on Seventy-Five models and 16.3 to 1 on Eldorado). 38.5° turning angle provides fast response and short turning diameter.

FRAME: Perimeter frame with boxed side rails. New front members afford added protection with increased energy absorption.

TIRES: Low-pressure, size 178–15, bias-belted, tiberglass, tubeless, on all models. Black side

walls, standard; white sidewalls available.

CORNERING LIGHTS: On the side of front fenders, activated by directional signal lever when headlamp switch is on. They project a beam of light from the side of the car, thus illuminating roadside and road signs for added convenience at night.

TREAD: Front 63.6", rear 63.3" (Eldorado, 63.66" front, 63.59" rear).

WHEELBASE: 130" (Fleetwood Sixty Special Brougham 133", Fleetwood Seventy-Five 151.5", Eldorado 126.3").

OVERALL LENGTH: 225.8" (Fleetwood Sixty Special Brougham 228.8", Fleetwood Seventy-Five 247.3", Eldorado 221.6").

ADDITIONAL BODY COLORS not shown on cars illustrated include: Cotillion White, Grenoble Silver, Sable Black, Zodiac Blue, Brittany Blue, Cypress Green, Sylvan Green, Desert Beige, Clove, Cambridge Red, Almond Firemist, and Primrose Firemist.

NOTE: Richly textured vinyl is provided in certain areas of leather-trimmed Fleetwood and DeVille models.
